The day of His appearing will come at last.

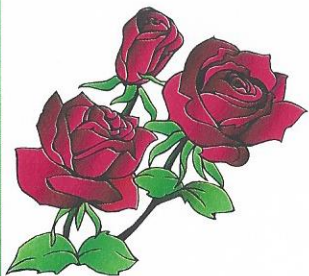
Rejoice, rejoice, O Christian, lift up your voice & sing

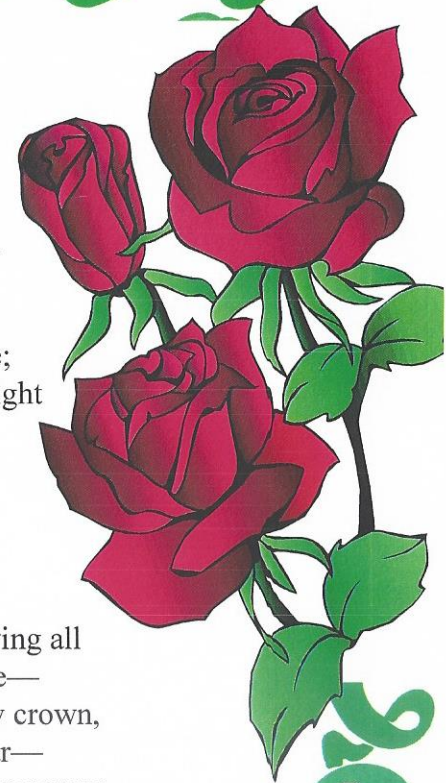
