are pure:

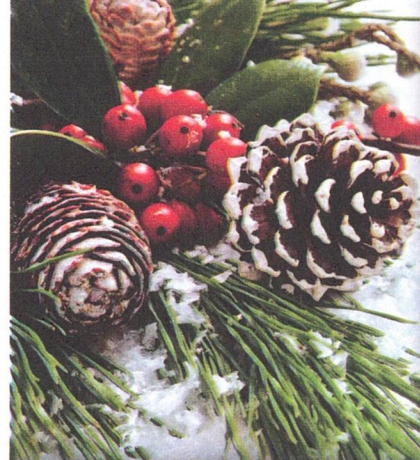
*But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and

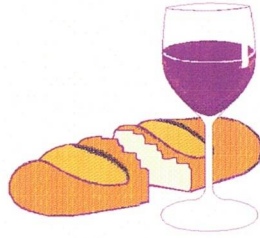

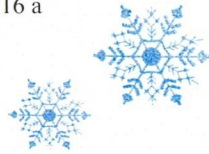
